RA's Letter of 11/2/05 to the Govenor

In the RA's 11/2/05 letter to the Governor setting out the milestones that the Government of PR needs to meet to demonstrate significant progress in implementing its Solid Waste Mgt. Program, the first milestone is the following:

By November 30, 2005, officially notify EPA, in writing (in English), of all changes that have been made to the PR solid waste regulations since EPA approved PR's Solid Waste Mgt. Program. Also identify any relevant transfers of responsibility between agencies, or between offices within EQB, that have occurred with respect to landfill permitting and enforcement.

Per Pat Durack's summary of the RA's meeting in PR, EQB repeated its claim that no regulatory changes have been made, so it is not clear if a response will be forthcoming.

The next milestone comes due on 12/30/05-the submission, in english, of the most recent solid waste mgt. plan, with associated financing plans.
